

## 國立臺灣大學圖書資訊學系徵聘專任教師(2名)

### 1.申請資格：

- 具圖書資訊學、自然語言處理、資訊檢索相關領域之博士學位。
- 能開授圖資系所必修課程者尤佳。

### 2.繳交資料：

- 博士學位證件影本（本國人持國外學歷者需經臺灣駐外使館／代表處認證）。若無博士學位證書者，須檢附臨時學位證明，且其中需載明起聘日前可取得博士學位。
  - 碩、博士班成績單。
  - 經歷證件影本。
  - 履歷表。
  - 著作目錄與代表作及參考作全文（需另寄目錄及文章全文之電子檔至 [lis@ntu.edu.tw](mailto:lis@ntu.edu.tw)）：以期刊、專書論文為代表作應至少二篇，專書得以一本為代表作。聘任為助理教授等級者，則得以其博士學位論文為代表作送審，請自行指定代表作與參考作。送審著作中，代表作應為應徵者取得前一等級教師資格後及本次聘任送審前五年內之著作；參考作應為應徵者取得前一等級教師資格後及本次聘任送審前七年內之著作。五年或七年內之起算日，以教師證書審定生效日往前推算五年或七年內（如為民國 116 年 2 月 1 日起聘者，須提供民國 111 年 2 月以後出版之代表作與民國 109 年 2 月以後出版之參考作；如為民國 116 年 8 月 1 日起聘，則須提供民國 111 年 8 月以後出版之代表作與民國 109 年 8 月以後出版之參考作）。

- 可授相關課程（含課程內容說明、授課大綱及參考書目）。

### 3.其他須知事項：

- 經本系新聘教師甄選委員會初審通過後，應徵者須親自至本系面談並進行一場學術演講，旅費等一切費用自理。
- 所有申請資料概不退還。

### 4.起聘時間及職級：

自民國 116 年 2 月 1 日或民國 116 年 8 月 1 日起聘；職級視申請者資歷而定。

## **Dept. of Library and Information Science in National Taiwan University is seeking to employ two full-time faculty**

### **1. Qualification:**

- \*Doctoral degree in library and information science, **natural language processing (NLP)**, **information retrieval (IR)** and related fields
- \*Those who can teach required courses in LIS are preferred

### **2. Documents Required:**

- \*Photocopy of doctoral diploma;  
Those who have not yet received the diploma at the time of application must provide a formal statement from the degree granting institution indicating that it will be in hand by the time of appointment
- \*Transcripts of the master's and doctoral studies
- \*Photocopy of working experience certification
- \*Resume
- \*List of publications and the full text of the representative and supporting works (must include print copy in the application package; must also send the electronic files to [lis@ntu.edu.tw](mailto:lis@ntu.edu.tw) )  
The applicant should designate his/her representative and supporting works and provide the full text of the works for the hiring review. The representative work should include at least two published journal articles/book chapters or one scholarly monograph. Doctoral dissertation may serve as the applicant's representative work if assistant professor is the intended rank. If appointment begins on February 1, 2027, the representative works should be published no earlier than February, 2022, and the supporting works should be published no earlier than February, 2020. If appointment begins on August 1, 2027, the representative works should be published no earlier than August, 2022, and the supporting works should be published no earlier than August, 2020.

- \* Course plans and syllabi (must include course introduction, teaching goals, weekly schedules for 16 weeks, and required readings).

### **3. Other Requirements:**

- \*The applicants who pass preliminary review by our search committee will be invited to give a presentation to our faculty (travel expenses to be paid by applicant)
- \*All applications will not be returned.

### **4. Date of appointment and position official rank:**

Appointment begins on February 1, 2027 or August 1, 2027. Official rank appointed is according to working experience and qualifications.
