- Requiring to use **English** for the competition.

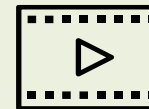

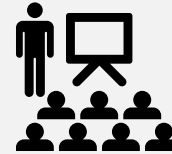

Finals & Awards Ceremony will host in National Taiwan University Sports Center, Taipei, Taiwan.

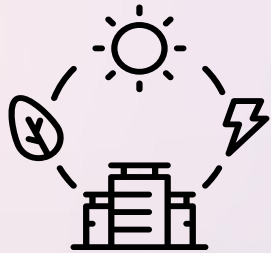
Finalists **must** physically attend to the Final round for the presentation and Awards Ceremony in Taiwan on **November 1st.**

- Live Final Presentation in Taiwan (6min presentation followed by 7-minute Q&A).

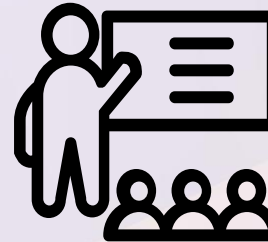
